- 2. All applicants must register to sit for the LSAT examination. Trinity will accept registration for the LSAT only with the Law School Data Assembly Service or applicants may choose full registration with the Law School Data Assembly Service. This service allows Trinity to obtain copies of the applicant's LSAT score. Applicants should follow the directions in the LSDAS/LSAT Information Book or on the LSAC web site. If you have questions regarding which registration option to choose, please call the Trinity Admissions Office at 714/796-7100. Your LSAT results will be sent directly to Trinity if you request them to do so; Trinity's school number is # 4268.
- 3. Contact each college and/or university attended to send transcripts to Trinity. All credits attempted/earned including undergraduate and graduate credit must be shown. Transcripts must be sealed bearing the certification of the issuing institution and must be sent directly to the Admissions Office.
- 4. Choose recommenders to submit recommendations directly to the Trinity Law School Admissions Office. No decision regarding law school admission will be rendered until the law school receives the completed recommendation forms.
- 5. Upon submission of the application, schedule an admissions interview. Please contact an admissions counselor at 714/ 796-7100 to arrange an interview and/or for a tour of the law school.
